

THE ULTIMATE EIBC PACKING LIST

CLOTHING

- Shorts
- T-shirts/modest tank tops
- Clothes/shoes to get dirty
- Dark clothing for night games
- Underwear
- Pajamas
- Pants/Jeans
- Jacket, fleece, or sweatshirt
- Rain gear
- Bathing suit (modest one-piece for girls, modest long shorts for boys)
- A dressy outfit (*week long camps only*)

LINENS

- Blanket/sheets or sleeping bag
- Pillow
- Bath Towel
- Beach Towel
- Laundry bag
- Plastic bag for wet clothing

MISCELLANEOUS

- Bible
- Journal, pen or pencil
- Flashlight with batteries
- Stationery & stamps to write home
- Sunscreen
- Bug Spray
- Water bottle
- Goggles
- Ziploc bags for candy/snacks

TOILETRIES

- Tooth brush/tooth paste
- Soap
- Shampoo/Conditioner
- Brush/Comb
- Hair accessories
- Deodorant

FOOTWEAR

- Tennis shoes
- Flip-flops
- Shower shoes

ITEMS TO LEAVE AT HOME

- Cell phones
- Video players
- mp3 players
- Pocket knives, paintball markers, airsoft guns, lighters, etc.
- We discourage you from bringing valuable personal items to camp as EIBC will not be held responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal items

MAIL AND PACKAGES

On registration day we will have bins where you can put mail or packages for your camper. There will be a bin labeled for each day of the week. If you want your camper to receive their package on Thursday, place it in the bin marked "Thursday," and so on. There will be a spot on your way out to drop this off so it will still be a surprise for your camper.

NOTE: Please do not include food in camper mail (attracts mice and insects). Thank you!

Things to keep in mind when packing
